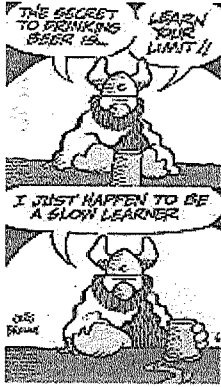

*A. Single women come home, see what's in the fridge & go to bed. Married women come home, see what's in the bed & go to the fridge.*

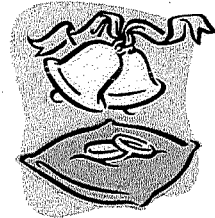

**Sktzo & I** trailered down (being old & all) along with **Hershel & Taz.** **Hershel** having fun with the walkie-talkies.



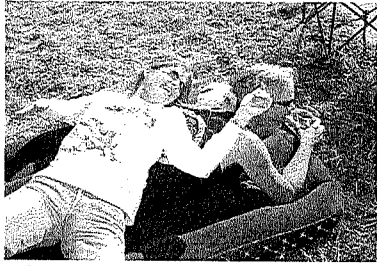
